IX.	STORAGE OF FOOD
	I understand that all food and merchandise shall be stored either inside or affixed to the sidewalk vendor receptacle or carried by the sidewalk vendor. Food and merchandise shall not be stored, placed, or kept on any public property. If affixed to the sidewalk vendor receptacle, the overall space taken up by the sidewalk vendor receptacle shall not exceed the maximum size allowed for a sidewalk vending receptacle. I understand that failure to comply with these requirements may result in fines or revocation of the Sidewalk Vending Permit.

X.	DISPLAY OF SIDEWALK VENDOR PERMIT
	I understand that the Sidewalk Vendor Permit shall be displayed conspicuously at all times on the sidewalk vending receptacle or the sidewalk vendor's person. If multiple sidewalk vendors are staffing a sidewalk vendor receptacle or working as roaming sidewalk vendors, each person shall wear his/her permit on his/her person in a conspicuous manner. I understand that failure to comply with these requirements may result in fines or revocation of the Sidewalk Vending Permit.

XI.	INSPECTION OF SIDEWALK VENDING RECEPTACLE(S)
	I understand that all sidewalk vendors shall allow a City police officer, firefighter, life safety services officer, or code enforcement officer, at any time, to inspect their sidewalk vending receptacle for compliance with the maximum size requirements and to ensure the safe operation of any heating elements used to prepare food. I understand that failure to comply with these requirements may result in fines or revocation of the Sidewalk Vending Permit.

XII.	DISPOSAL OF TRASH
	I understand that sidewalk vendors that sell food shall maintain a trash container in or on their sidewalk vending receptacle and shall not empty their trash into public trashcans. Additionally, the size of the trash container shall be taken into account when assessing the maximum size limit of a sidewalk vending receptacle. Sidewalk vendors shall not leave any location without first picking up, removing, and disposing of all trash or refuse from their operation. I understand that failure to comply with these requirements may result in fines or revocation of the Sidewalk Vending Permit.

XIII.	COMPLIANCE WITH NOISE STANDARDS
	I understand that sidewalk vendors shall comply with the noise standards provided in Chapter 7.25 of the Laguna Beach Municipal Code, and any successor chapters. I understand that failure to comply with this requirement may result in fines or revocation of the Sidewalk Vending Permit.

XIV.	HOURS OF OPERATION
	I understand that all sidewalk vendors, regardless of whether a roaming sidewalk vendor or stationary sidewalk vendor, are prohibited from conducting sidewalk vending activities between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. daily. In residential areas, all stationary sidewalk vending is prohibited. In residential areas, roaming sidewalk vending activity is prohibited between the hours of 6:00 p.m. or sunset, whichever is earlier, and 9:00 a.m. of the following day, Monday through Saturday, inclusive, and all day on Sundays and federal holidays. I understand that failure to comply with these requirements may result in fines or revocation of the Sidewalk Vending Permit.

XV.	PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES
	I understand that all sidewalk vendors shall not engage in: (1) renting merchandise to customers; (2) displaying merchandise or food that is not available for immediate sale; (3) selling adult-oriented material, cannabis, or alcohol; or (4) use an open flame on or within any sidewalk vending receptacle.

### II. PROXIMITY REQUIREMENTS FOR STATIONARY SIDEWALK VENDING SITE LOCATION

The proposed site maintains a minimum four (4) foot clear accessible path free from obstructions, including sidewalk vending receptacles and customer queuing area.			
The proposed	I site is not within twelve (12) inches of any curb face on all roads.		
The proposed	I site is not within fifteen (15) feet of any entrance or exit to a building, structure or facility.		
	I site is not on any designated emergency vehicle accessway. Such accessways include, but d to, Treasure Island Park, Heisler Park, and the Main Beach cobblestone area.		
	I site is not on any public property that does not meet the definition of a sidewalk or uding without limitation any alley, park, beach, street, roadway or parking lot;		
The proposed site is not within the immediate vicinity of an area designated for a temporary special permit issued by the City, during the limited duration of the temporary special permit.			
The proposed lessee of	I site is not on any private property without the express written consent of the owner or property.		
The proposed	I site is not within fifty (50) feet of another sidewalk vendor.		
The proposed site is not within one hundred (100) feet of a school, a place of worship, or a child day-care facility.			
The proposed site is not within two hundred (200) feet of a permitted certified farmers' market or swap meet during the limited operating hours of that certified farmers' market or swap meet.			
The sidewalk	s or pathways at the proposed site has a minimum width of eight (8) feet or larger.		
The proposed site is not within twenty-five (25) feet of a:			
a.	Fire hydrant;		
b.	Curb which has been designated as yellow or red zone, or a bus zone;		
c.	Automated teller machine;		
d.	Driveway, alley, or street corner;		
e.	Trash or recycling receptacles, bike racks, benches, bus stops or similar public use items; and		
f.	Public art objects, items, and displays.

The proposed site does not violate provisions of this code relating to visibility requirements for streets, alleys, driveways, and intersections.
The proposed site is not in a location where the City has signed a concessionary agreement.
The sidewalk or pathway at the proposed site does not have a gradient in excess of ten percent (10%).
The proposed site is not within two hundred (200) feet of any public safety facility, including without limitation police stations, fire stations, marine safety headquarters, and lifeguard towers.
The proposed site is not within twenty-four (24) inches of a parallel parking space.
The sidewalk at the proposed site is not adjacent to a state highway AND the presence of vending equipment, vendor and queuing patrons maintains clearance greater than four (4) feet.
OR
The sidewalk at the proposed site is adjacent to a state highway AND the presence of vending equipment, vendor and queuing patrons maintains a clearance greater than five (5) feet, with temporary restrictions of no less than three (3) feet.
