About The NCS™

The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™) report is about the "livability" of Laguna Beach. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents' opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 553 residents of the City of Laguna Beach collected from November 19th, 2021 to January 12th, 2022. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 4.2% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2021 survey was 20%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Laguna Beach.





How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Laguna Beach's results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Laguna Beach residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Laguna Beach's average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was "much higher" or "much lower," then Laguna Beach's average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered during the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your City's 2021 ratings compare to other communities' ratings from the past five years.

Trends over time

Trend data for Laguna Beach represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines*. Deviations from stable trends over time represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs, or public information may have affected residents' opinions. Changes between survey years have been noted with an arrow and the percent difference. If the difference is greater than 6.4 percentage points between the 2012 and 2021 surveys, the change is statistically significant.

* In 2020, The NCS survey was updated to include new and refreshed items. Consequently, some of the trends may be impacted due to wording modifications that could have potentially altered the meaning of the item for the respondent.


Methods

Selecting survey recipients

All households within the City of Laguna Beach were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Laguna Beach was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve the City of Laguna Beach households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of the City of Laguna Beach boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the "person whose birthday has most recently passed" to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

Conducting the survey

The 2,700 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on November 26th, 2021 and the survey remained open for seven weeks. For 1,200 households, the first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. The final mailing contained a reminder letter, another survey, and a postage-paid return envelope. For the remaining 1,500 households, the first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate, followed one week later by a reminder postcard. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those

who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

Of the 2,700 households that received the invitations to participate, 553 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 20%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR's response rate #2* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a "level of confidence" and accompanying "confidence interval" (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents' opinions are relied on to estimate all residents' opinions. The margin of error for the City of Laguna Beach survey is no greater than plus or minus 4.2 percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (553 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected "probability sample" of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Laguna Beach. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with one small update; it included a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on December 29th, 2021. The survey remained open for two weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a "key and verify" method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2010 Census and 2019 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Laguna Beach. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

NRC aligns demographic labels with those used by the U.S. Census for reporting purposes, when possible. Some categories (e.g., age, race/Hispanic origin, housing type, and length of residency) are combined into smaller subgroups.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Highlights

Note: this overview of key findings is reflective of the results from the scientific, mail-based survey of 553 randomly selected households in the City of Laguna Beach. The results from the community-wide, open-participation survey are reported separately in the "open participation survey results" section. The results from the scientific, random-sample survey represent the most robust estimate of resident opinion and should be considered the "main" survey results.

Laguna Beach residents continue to enjoy a very high quality of life.

Virtually all survey respondents rated Laguna Beach as a place to live and the overall quality of life in the City as positive, and about 9 in 10 favorably rated the overall image or reputation of the city and their neighborhood as a place to live. Around 8 in 10 residents gave positive ratings to Laguna Beach as a place to retire, the sense of community in the city, and residents' connection and engagement with their community, with at least an additional 15% of respondents rating each of these as neutral. These ratings were all higher than those given in other communities across the nation. Further, about 9 in 10 residents were very or somewhat likely to recommend living in Laguna Beach to someone who asked and planned to remain in the community for the next five years, and 8 in 10 felt that the city was a good place to raise children; these scores were on par with the national averages.

Economic health remains a feature of the community, with some ratings increasing over time.

About three-quarters of survey respondents gave positive ratings to the overall economic health of Laguna Beach and another 2 in 10 rated this as neutral. Virtually all residents gave favorable marks to the city as a place to visit, which was much higher than the national benchmark. About 7 in 10 survey participants gave positive scores to the vibrancy of the downtown/commercial area and 2 in rated this as neutral; this rating also surpassed the national average. Further, while similar to the benchmarks, ratings for the overall quality of business and service establishments (73% positive, 21% neutral) and shopping opportunities (58% positive, 29% neutral) increased in 2021 from the previous iteration of the survey in 2012.

Government performance ratings in Laguna Beach are on par with those given elsewhere across the nation.

When evaluating their local government and aspects of public trust, Laguna Beach residents gave ratings that were similar to the national averages. At least 7 in 10 residents gave positive ratings to the overall quality of services provided by the City, overall customer service by Laguna Beach employees, and public information services, with roughly 2 in 10 giving each of these a neutral rating. For most aspects of public trust - such as the overall direction of the City, generally acting in the best interest of the community, being honest, and treating all residents fairly - about half of residents awarded positive marks, while about 3 in 10 gave a neutral rating and 2 in 10 gave a poor rating. Most government performance ratings remained stable from 2012 to 2022 except for the overall direction of the City, the overall quality of City services, the value of services for taxes paid and welcoming resident involvement, which declined.

Community Design is an area of opportunity for the City.

The facet of Community Design encompasses the livability and impact on quality of life of community aspects such as the City's overall design and layout, residential and commercial growth, public places, housing affordability and variety, and development and land use, among others. About 8 in 10 residents gave positive ratings to public places where people want to spend time, which was higher than the national average, and to the overall appearance of the city, which was similar. About three-quarters of residents gave positive ratings to the overall design or layout of residential and commercial areas and to the preservation of the historical or cultural character of the community, with another 2 in 10 rating each of these as neutral; these ratings were also similar to national averages. However, ratings declined from 2012 to 2021 for several aspects related to Community Design:

- The overall quality of new development in Laguna Beach 40% positive/36% neutral/25% negative (24% decrease)
- Code enforcement 50% positive/29% neutral/21% negative (14% decrease)
- Variety of housing options 28% positive/35% neutral/38% negative (13% decrease)
- Overall appearance of the city 82% positive/14% neutral/3% poor (11% decrease)
- Land use, planning, and zoning 45% positive/33% neutral/23% negative (10% decrease).

Further, evaluations for variety of housing options (28% positive/35% neutral /38% negative), well-planned commercial growth (29% positive/34% neutral/38% negative), and availability of affordable quality housing (13% positive/19% neutral/67% negative) were lower than scores given in other communities nationwide.

Finally, in a custom question unique to Laguna Beach asking residents to rate their level of support for or opposition a series of


City initiatives (refer to chart below), residents were most likely to show support for further streamlining the Design Review process for rebuilding homes (90% strongly or somewhat support), taking over Laguna Canyon Road from Caltrans in order to underground overhead utilities (86%), and converting Lower Forest Avenue to a permanent pedestrian plaza (83%).

Mobility is another challenge area in Laguna Beach, but residents are supportive of alternative transportation options.

About three-quarters of Laguna Beach residents positively rated the ease of walking in the city, and 6 in 10 residents rated the overall quality of the transportation system in Laguna Beach as positive, with another one-third rating it as neutral. These ratings were similar to the national benchmarks. Scores related to alternative transportation tended to be higher than the national averages, with 8 in 10 residents indicating they had walked or biked in the past 12 months, and about half reporting having used public transportation or carpooling instead of driving. The rating for bus or transit services, at 66% positive/24% neutral/10% negative, was also above average. However, only about one-quarter of survey respondents gave positive ratings to traffic flow on major streets, ease of public parking, ease of travel by car, and ease of travel by bicycle, with roughly an additional 4 in 10 giving each a neutral rating. These scores were lower or much lower than the national comparisons.

Finally, when asked to rate their level of support for or opposition a series of City initiatives (refer to chart below), a strong majority of respondents showed support for initiatives related to transportation and improved mobility in the city. These included taking over Laguna Canyon Road from Caltrans in order to make pedestrian improvements (79% strongly or somewhat support), to make high occupancy vehicle traffic and transit improvements (78%), and to make bicycle improvements (77%), as well as developing a Master Plan of parking for the City to provide additional parking throughout town (78%) and to build new parking facilities (74%).


Balancing performance and importance

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide City staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.


Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 83% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 83% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 83% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 83%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.



Quality of life

Measuring community livability starts with assessing the quality of life of those who live there, and ensuring that the community is attractive, accessible, and welcoming to all.








What impact, if any, do you think the economy will have on your family income in the next 6 months? Do you think the impact will be:

Overall quality of the transportation system in Laguna Beach, 2021

















Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™), the City of Laguna Beach conducted a survey of 553 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from November 19th, 2021 to January 12th, 2022. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Laguna Beach. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with one small update; it included a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on December 29th, 2021. The survey remained open for two weeks and there were 1,290 responses.


The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2010 Census and 2019 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Laguna Beach. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the open participation survey are presented in the following table.


