

LOS ANGELES -- In the style of some of the greats, yet adding her own modern twist, Kiki Kyte bursts on the scene with a new single, "Disco Chick," a top-of-chart disco hit, already cutting a swath in Europe.

Kiki has been mentored by and toured with some of the best musicians from around the world, and with "Disco Chick," she brings her exuberance and youthful style to create her own "new disco" genre.

Being on the dance floor and laughing and having a wonderful time is what everyone dreams about and I wanted to capture that feeling. My song is about freedom and love and carefree times. 'Disco Chick' is my way of telling people to lighten up, have fun and feel the love."

Kiki's voice came through loud and clear last year when she was featured in the light-hearted roller-disco-glittery video "Good Time," from the single of the same name. Living in Los Angeles, Kiki is a far ways from her southern roots. She got her training coming up singing gospel in the church since the time she was only five years old.

"I want to bring back the disco sound but give it a modern twist," Kiki said. Music goes through trends and I know the trend is to get dancing. My music gives people that freedom."


