## **City Fees Updated**

Last night, the City Council approved fee increases to various application and permit types that will go into effect as of July 1<sup>st</sup>. On average, the new fees will provide 69% cost recovery while the rest will continue to be subsidized by the City. The increased cost recovery will provide new positions to improve service levels and entitlement processing timeframes. Many of the new positions will replace existing contracts with consultants to provide better quality and consistency in service. For more information, click here to review the staff report.
