## **Recap of Minutes**

1) Karen Wood called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

- 2) Minutes of the June 12, 2023, meeting were approved as presented. M/S Kollenda/Chauvel.
- 3) Chair's Announcements: Karen Wood congratulated returning commissioners and welcomed newly appointed commissioners.
- 4) Commissioner and Staff Communications: Austin Barrow noted attending Music in the Park on July 9, 2023. Staff McGregor noted the Music in the Park concert on July 9, 2023, was well attended and a successful start to the season. Staff noted Community Art Project was exhibiting artwork by local students at City Hall and thanked Michael Ervin for representing the Commission at the exhibition reception on July 6, 2023. Staff noted the Cultural Arts Department was accepting entries for the Juried Fine Art and Council Chamber Banner Competitions. Staff noted Cultural Arts Funding Grant checks were ready for distribution and would be mailed with letters from Mayor Whalen. Staff Poeschl recognized Public Works employee Rick Weirs for his years of service with the Music in the Park concerts and noted staff would plan a thank you for him on July 23, 2023. Staff noted that, once appointed, Arts Commission officers would meet with staff to discuss grant opportunities for individual artists. Staff shared former Public Art Coordinator Jamie Bichler's documentation of ownership information, approval dates and timelines for public murals throughout the city. Staff noted booking for the Promenade on Forest would begin for September through December 2023, and there would be a brief performance by No Square Theatre on July 11, 2023. Staff noted the temporary sculpture "Inquire Within" would be installed on July 31, 2023, at City Hall, and thanked Commissioners for attending the dedication of "We Need to Talk" at the telephone booth on Forest Avenue. Staff noted that Casey Parlette completed the installation of the Art in Public Places mural for Coast Liquor. Staff noted working with Community Development to streamline the Artist Review Panel Process.

#### Overview

The City of Laguna Beach Juried Fine Art Exhibition is currently in its 17<sup>th</sup> year. The deadline for artwork submission is August 27, 2023. The exhibition will be installed at City Hall from September 25, 2023, to November 16, 2023. Awards will be announced on November 2, 2023.

#### **Summary of the Matter**

The Arts Commission must approve a qualified juror to review and select artwork for the exhibition from the field of entries. Staff recommends artist Gerard Basil Stripling as juror for the 2023 exhibition. Mr. Stripling is a notable local artist with work in the City's public art collection and a recipient various awards including Laguna Beach Arts Alliance's "2023 Artist of the Year." His artwork was also featured in a 2023 solo exhibition at the Laguna Art Museum.

SUBJECT: Temporary Mural Collection (Item 6C)

Laguna Beach is fortunate in having more than 30 murals installed throughout the city, a concentration of which are in the Civic Arts District and Downtown. Many of the murals are privately owned and funded and have been reviewed and approved by the Arts Commission. When reviewing the mural proposals, the Commission on occasion has stipulated timeframes for exhibit, temporary being 12 months or less and long term being based on the materials used for installation. An update on the status of the existing murals is warranted, to discuss expired permitted murals and their condition.

The City does not own many buildings within the Downtown to facilitate installations but has made the process of approval for private projects, streamlined and free of any permit charge. From application to approval can be undertaken in 21 days. The Cultural Arts Department does not maintain an inventory of properties interested in hosting temporary murals as owners and businesses change and there has been little an interest or commitment other than through non-profit organizations.

Staff has prepared the attached report of existing murals, their status, and their condition. Additional installations exist and staff will continue to update the document. It is recommended that the Commission review the installations and staff recommendations and take the necessary action on 12 of the existing murals.
