Vehicles will not be permitted to enter drop-off area after 12:00 p.m.

IMPORTANT SAFETY REMINDERS

- ▶ Materials should be in original containers.
- ▶ All containers must have lids, be sturdy and secure, non-leaking, labeled and protected from breakage.
- ▶ Materials will only be accepted from vehicles.
- ▶ Pedestrian traffic is not allowed.
- ▶ Waste is strictly limited to residents and small businesses.
- ▶ Residents Only: Please bring proof of residency
- ▶ Businesses Only: Please bring Business License Number

- Large Containers (over 5 gallons)
- Hazardous household wastes that are not considered universal waste such as, but not limited to, compressed gas cylinders (aerosols are acceptable), flammable liquids, oxidizers, toxics, corrosives and state regulated materials.

The collection center nearest to Laguna Beach is the Irvine facility, located at 6411 Oak Canyon. Residents may schedule one free pick-up of eligible materials per year. Call Waste Management At Your Door Special Collection at 1-800-449-7587 to schedule a pick-up.</p> <p>The City also offers a Small Business program created to assist with proper management and disposal of hazardous waste. To qualify for this service businesses must generate less than 220 lbs. of hazardous waste per month and have accumulated less than 2200 lbs. in one year.
