

Business Parking Permit

Valid August 1, 2020 to July 31, 2021 Cost \$300

(Permits are pro-rated to \$150 as of February 1st, 2020)

- ONLY available to owners and employees of businesses located within the Downtown Specific Plan. (See Map)
 - The Map is ONLY to be used to determine eligibility of businesses that can apply for a business parking permit. The Map is NOT to be used for determining where parking is permitted with a business parking permit. See below on where parking is permitted.
- Proof of business ownership or employment in the Downtown Business District is required.
- Examples of proof are: a paycheck stub or a letter written on business letterhead from employer.
- Permit allows parking for a maximum of 12 hours at approved meters only. (see below)
- Permit holder is not guaranteed a parking space. There are approximately 75 - 130 spaces available for parking at the designated locations.
- **This permit does not allow parking at any other location.**

Parking Is Only Permitted At Meters On:

- Cliff Drive between Aster Street and Acacia Drive.
- Glenneyre parking structure upper level on the Glenneyre Street side (east side brick wall): Monday through Friday during the school year only (9/8/20 - 6/10/21).
- Laguna Canyon Road on the Eastbound side during the school year (9/8/20 - 6/10/21).

Important Information for Permit Holders

- Permits are not valid during the Summer Festival Season (June 18th – September 8th) on Laguna Canyon Road.
- Fees are non-refundable.
- Permits are not transferable from vehicle to vehicle
- **If the vehicle is damaged, sold, or if there is a change in employees, you must remove the old permit and return it to obtain a replacement permit for \$2.00 (The full price will apply if you do not present the old permit for replacement.)**
- Stickers must be permanently affixed to the **LOWER LEFT REAR BUMPER under the taillight or to the OUTSIDE LOWER LEFT corner of the REAR WINDOW** to be valid.
- Permits are available for purchase at the cashier counter at City Hall located at: 505 Forest Ave.
